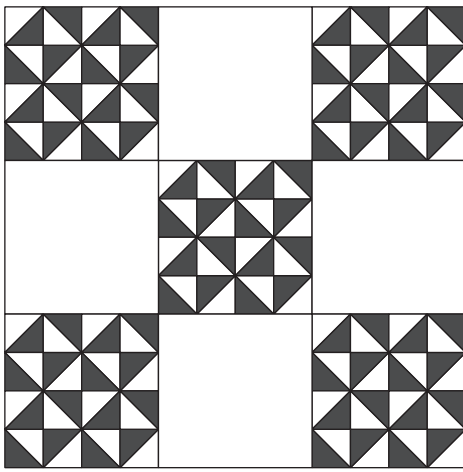
Fabric Requirements:

White Fat qtr.

Red Fat qtr.

Triangle Paper™: 1 sheet 1" Half Square

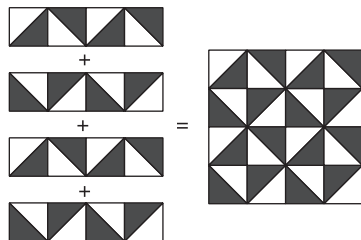
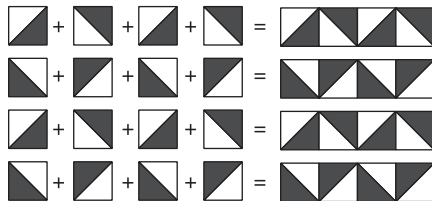


Cutting and Piecing:

1. Cut white fabric and red fabric slightly larger than the outside lines of the grid on the paper. Layer these fabrics right sides together, with paper against lighter fabric. Stitch on all the dashed lines, cut on all the solid lines, tear paper away, and press seams toward the darker fabric.

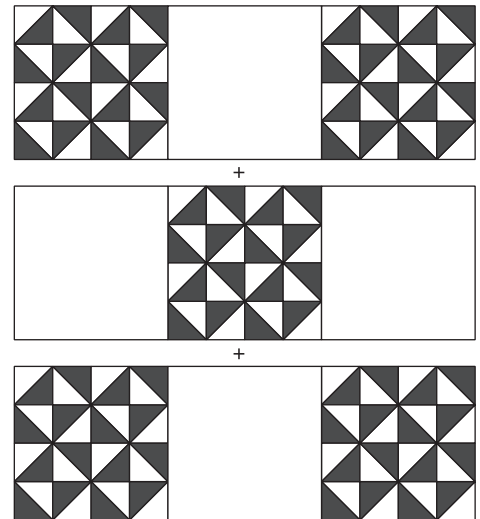
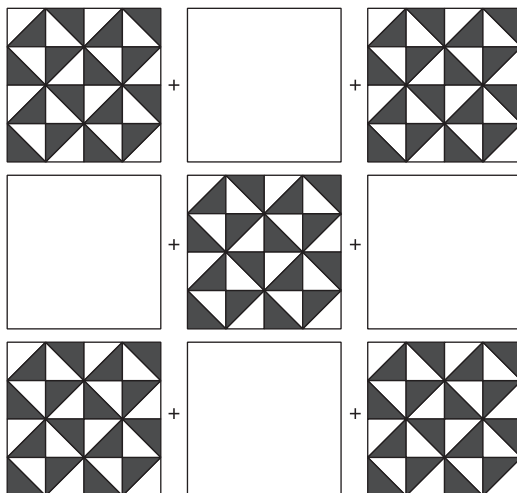
2. From white, cut 4 -4½" squares.

3. Piece 4 squares as shown. Piece squares into rows, then piece the rows together.



4. Piece the quilt top as shown here.

Piece in rows, then piece the rows together.



5. Layer, quilt, and bind. Why not try redwork embroidery in the blank blocks, or quilt in a thread color that matches the fabric used, if you chose something other than red.
