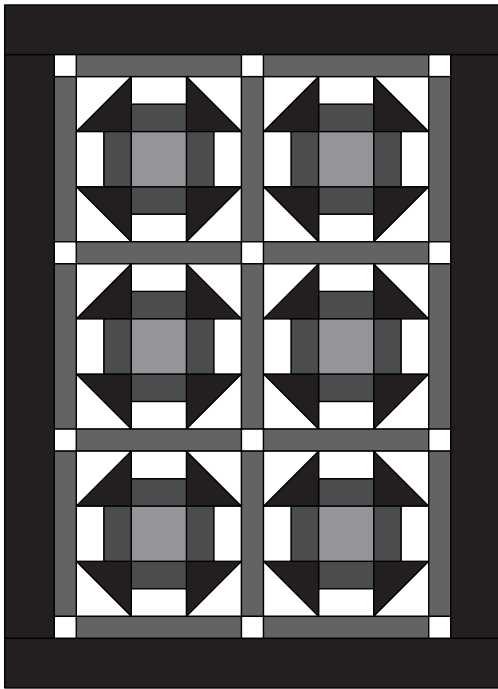


Churn Dash

Fabric Requirements:

| | |
|-------------|----------|
| White | ½ yard |
| Black print | ½ yard |
| Red | ¼ yard |
| Theme print | Fat qtr. |
| Check | ⅛ yard |
| Solid black | ¼ yard |


Triangle Paper™: 1 sheet 2½" Half Square

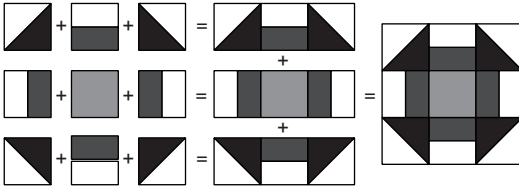
Cutting:

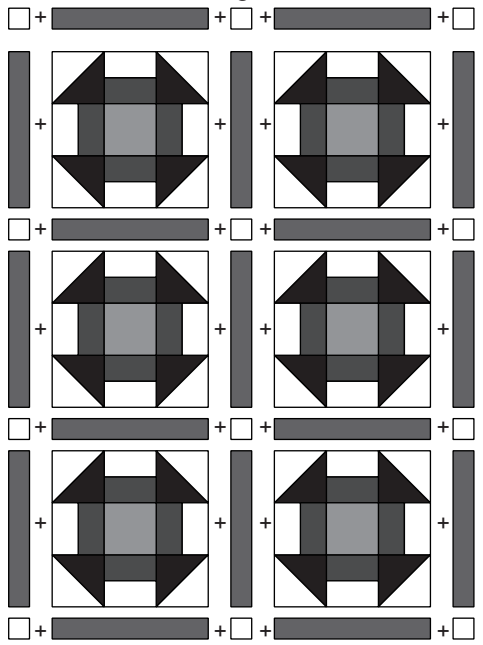
1. From white, cut 2 strips 1¾" x width of fabric. Cut 1 rectangle slightly larger than the outside lines of the paper grid.
2. From red, cut 2 strips 1¾" x width of fabric.
3. From black print, cut 1 rectangle slightly larger than the outside lines of the paper grid.
4. From solid black, cut 2 strips, 1½" wide x width of fabric. Cross-cut into 17 -8" strips.
5. From check, cut 1 strip 1½" x width of fabric. Cross-cut into 12 -1½" squares.
6. From theme fabric, cut 1 strip 2½" wide x width of fabric. Cross-cut into 6 -2½" squares.

Piecing the Blocks:

1. Layer black print fabric and white fabric right sides together; place paper against white fabric. Stitch on all the dashed lines, cut on all the solid lines, tear paper away, and press seams toward darker fabric.

2. Sew white strips and red strips together. Cross-cut into 24 -2½" squares.
 

3. Piece the block together. Sew the squares together into rows, then sew the rows together.
 

4. Piece the top together. Sew the pieces together into rows, then sew the rows together.
 

5. Measure and cut the outside borders. The sides should measure 26½". Attach side borders first. Measure for top and bottom. This should measure 18". Attach top and bottom borders.

6. The quilt pictured on the cover has a small flange type border that was put with the outside border. Cut strips ½" wide, fold in half, wrong sides together. Place raw edges along raw edge of outside border.
