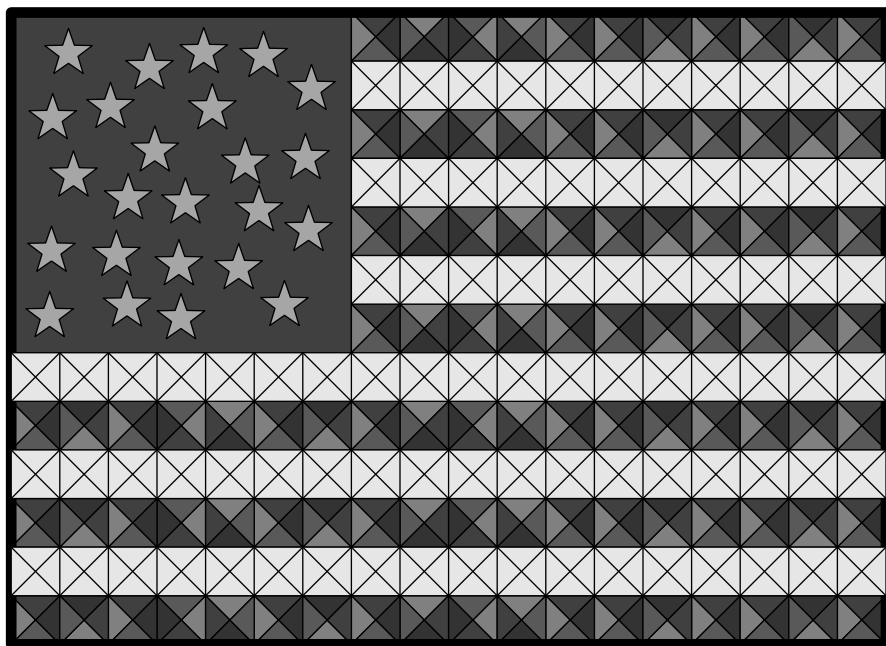


Flags-A-Waving



Requirements:

13 sheets 2½" Quarter Square Triangle Paper™ (7 sheets for the reds and 6 sheets for the lights.)

Fat quarters and fat eights would be fine as long as you had LOTS of different fabrics. My lights ranged from creams to yellows to beiges to 2-color prints. My reds ran the gamut from clear to rust to dark to maroon, to pinkish. In both the lights and the reds I also included medium values.

Star portion of flag – fat quarter of star fabric

Binding: ½ yard

1. Cut Triangle Paper™ on the vertical solid lines to create strips so that you do not have as many repeats of pairs.

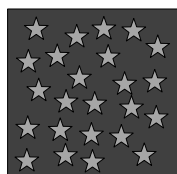
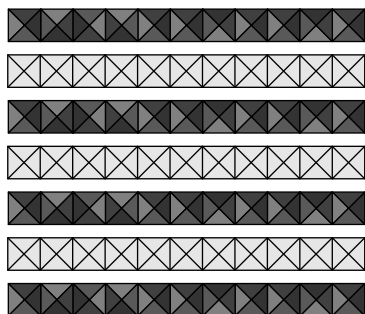
2. Cut fabric slightly larger than the paper strip. Layer reds with reds and lights with lights, right sides together, with the paper strip on top of the lighter of the two fabrics. You must be consistent when you are piecing with quarter square triangle paper.

3. Piece the triangle units together to complete the square. Make 98 triangle squares of reds and 87 triangle squares of lights.

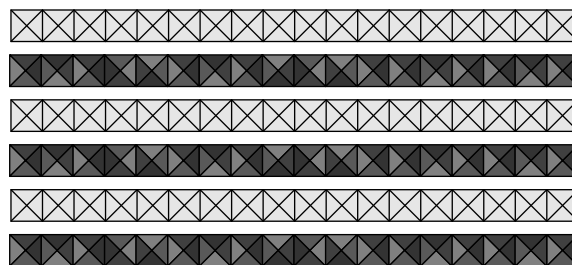


4. I used a fabric that had lots of stars on it for the star portion of the flag. Cut the star fabric 18" x 18".

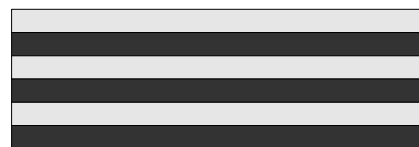
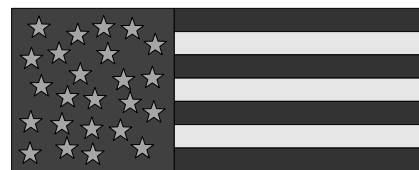
5. Piece the squares together into rows, then piece the rows together as shown to the right. Then attach the star square to the first seven rows as shown below.



6. Continue piecing the last six rows together.



7. Add these rows to the section completed in step 5.



8. Layer, quilt, and bind.

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
